This is a consent form for research participation. It contains important information about this research study and what to expect if you decide to participate.

Your participation is voluntary. Please think about the information in this form carefully. If you want—feel free to ask us questions before deciding about whether or not you want to participate (**Email Me:** mcinroy.1@osu.edu). If you decide to participate, you will be asked to electronically sign this form.

You may leave the survey at any time. If you decide to stop participating, there will be no consequence to you, and you will not lose any benefits to which you are otherwise entitled. Your decision will not affect your future relationship with The Ohio State University.

Purpose. This research study is trying to understand LGBTQIA+ young peoples' daily experiences with negativity and discrimination online, and how they deal with those experiences. This study also wants to better understand the potential consequences of these experiences on LGBTQIA+ young peoples' mental health and wellbeing. What we find out will be used to help develop supports for young people struggling with the online hostility they experience.

Criteria to Participate.

- Currently be age 14 – 24
- Identify as LGBTQIA+
- Live in the United States, Canada, or the United Kingdom
- Use the Internet

Tasks & Duration:

After you sign this consent form, you will be asked to complete a brief 30-minute survey about yourself and your experiences as a LGBTQIA+ young person online. ***You do not have to answer any questions that you do not want to answer.*** There are just a few required questions, so we know you fit the study requirements and are a real person.

During the survey you will be asked if you would like to participate in an interview. If you say ‘yes’—that you are interested in participating in an interview—and you are selected to be interviewed, a member of the Research Team will reach out using the email address you give us with more information. By indicating that you are interested in participating in an interview, you agree to be contacted using the email address you provide by the Research Team. You can change your mind about participating in an interview at any time.

You may leave the study at any time. If you decide to stop participating in the study, there will be no penalty to you, and you will not lose any benefits to which you are otherwise entitled. Your decision will not affect your future relationship with The Ohio State University.

Risks and Benefits:

There are some risks to your participation. You may become upset talking about your past experiences with negativity and discrimination online. You are always able to take a break or stop taking the survey at any time. Links to resources to support you are available at the start and end of the survey.

There are also benefits to your participation. You may feel good about sharing your experiences and expertise with the researchers. You will also be contributing to society generally through your participation in the study, providing new and important knowledge for mental health and health providers (like social workers and guidance counsellors) about online experiences and contributing to the development of resources for LGBTQIA+ youth who need support.

Confidentiality:

We will work to make sure that no one sees your online responses without approval. But, because we are using the Internet, there is a chance that someone could access your online responses without permission. In some cases, this information could be used to identify you. Once we receive it, your information will be stored securely according to The Ohio State University data storage protocols.

Also, there may be circumstances where this information must be released. For example, personal information regarding your participation in this study may be disclosed if required by state law. Also, your records may be reviewed by the following groups (as applicable to the research):

- Office for Human Research Protections or other federal, state, or international regulatory agencies;

- The Ohio State University Institutional Review Board or Office of Responsible Research Practices;
- The sponsor, if any, or agency (including the Food and Drug Administration for FDA-regulated research) supporting the study.

Future Research:

You agree that our de-identified (aka. anonymous) information may be used or shared with other researchers without your additional informed consent.

Gift Card Raffle:

The compensation for participation in the survey is an entry into a raffle for one of forty (40 x \$25.00 USD) e-gift cards to Amazon. If you live in Canada or the United Kingdom, and win a gift card, the value will be equivalent to \$25.00 USD on the day it is processed. You only have to enter the raffle if you want to. The odds of receiving a gift card are approximately 1 in 10.

By law, payments to participants are considered taxable income.

Participant Rights:

You may refuse to participate in this study without penalty or loss of benefits to which you are otherwise entitled. If you are a student or employee at Ohio State, your decision will not affect your grades or employment status.

If you choose to participate in the study, you may discontinue participation at any time without penalty or loss of benefits. By agreeing to participate, you do not give up any personal legal rights you may have as a participant in this study.

An Institutional Review Board responsible for human subjects research at The Ohio State University reviewed this research project and found it to be acceptable, according to applicable state and federal regulations and University policies designed to protect the rights and welfare of participants in research.
